Learning Objectives	Students will be able to:
	- Identify adjectives in sentences.
	- Use adjectives to describe nouns (people, places, and things).
	- Enhance their sentences by adding adjectives.
Materials Needed	- Adjective Adventure Cards (printed adjective cards)
	- Whiteboard and markers
	- "Adjective Collector" game (digital tool or app, if available)

Introduction	Begin with a short story about a bland town that becomes colorful once adjectives are introduced.
Instruction	1. Explain what adjectives are and how they are used to describe nouns.
	2. Show examples on the whiteboard, highlighting adjectives in sentences.
Gamification Elements	- Adjective Adventure Cards : Students draw cards to find adjectives that match pictures on the board.
	- Points System: Earn points for correct use and creative sentences in activities.
Activities	1. Adjective Match-Up: Match adjectives with nouns in a timed challenge.
	2. Create Your World : Students use adjectives to describe a picture of a park, house, or classroom.
Assessment	- Informal observation during activities.
	- Complete a worksheet where they fill in adjectives in sentences.
Reflection	Discuss what new adjectives students learned and how they can use them in everyday conversation.
Homework/ Extension	Students write a short paragraph describing their bedroom using at least five new adjectives.
Evaluation	Review completed worksheets for understanding and ability to use adjectives

Implementation Notes:

- Interactive Introduction: Use the story to engage students and set the context for learning about adjectives. Encourage students to think of adjectives that might describe their town.
- Digital Integration: If available, use a simple digital game like "Adjective Collector" where students can drag and drop adjectives to match pictures or scenes on an interactive whiteboard or tablets.
- Collaboration: During the "Create Your World" activity, encourage students to work in pairs
 to foster collaborative learning and creativity.
- Feedback: Provide immediate feedback during activities to reinforce learning and correct misunderstandings.
