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## Lesson Plan: Let's rediscover the UK! (ELT)

<b>Lesson Title</b>	Let's rediscover the UK!

<b>Duration</b>	50 minutes
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	Students will be able to:
	- Recognize some of the most important landmarks in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
	- Distinguish some of the social customs in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
	- Recognize some of the most important landmarks in London
	- Indicate measures of environment protection while sightseeing
	- Feel more positive and enjoying when interacting with others in English
	- Use English while doing funny activities
<b>Materials Needed</b>	- UK Cards
	- Laptop
	- PowerPoint Presentation: Let's rediscover the UK!
	- Whiteboard and markers
	- Online games
	- Worksheets for practice

<b>Introduction</b>	<p>Using Mentimeter, students have to brainstorm what words comes through their minds when they think about the UK</p> <p>Begin with a short game of cards, in which the students have to associate the images on the cards with their names ( Landmarks from across the UK)</p> <p>After that follows the PowerPoint Presentation – Let’s rediscover the UK!</p>
<b>Instruction</b>	<p>1. Students are expected to write on their worksheets the name of each landmark they know, from the PPT. They also have the pictures on printed cards. For every correct answer, one point will ne assigned. At the end of the lesson, points will be turned into grades.</p> <p>2. Students will play the online games and their scores will be kept.</p> <p>3. Students will write a few things about their favourite landmark and then talk about it with their peers.</p>
<b>Gamification Elements</b>	<p>- <b>UK Landmarks Cards:</b> Students draw cards to find adjectives that match pictures on the board.</p> <p>- <b>Points System:</b> Earn points for correct association of pictures with landmarks in activities.</p> <p>- <b>Online Games:</b> Higher scores equals higher grades.</p>
<b>Activities</b>	<p>1. <b>Landmarks Match-Up:</b> Match images with landmarks names in a timed challenge.</p> <p>2. <b>I want to go there:</b> Students choose their favourite landmark and write in 5 sentences a few things about it. In pairs, students talk about their favourite landmarks.</p>
<b>Assessment</b>	<p>- Informal observation during activities.</p> <p>- Complete a worksheet where they fill in the names of the landmarks.</p> <p>- Online games score.</p>
<b>Reflection</b>	Discuss what it means to go sightseeing in a sustainable way.
<b>Homework/Extension</b>	Students write a short paragraph of minimum 6 lines, describing the measures of environment protections they would use while sighseeing in the UK.
<b>Evaluation</b>	Review completed worksheets for score.
	Online games score.

#### Implementation Notes:

- **Interactive Introduction:** Use the cards and the PowerPoint Presentation to reactivate previous knowledge regarding landmarks from the UK and especially from London. Encourage students to think what they prefer, when it comes to sightseeing.

- **Digital Integration:** Use digital games where students can match pictures of landmarks with their names.
- **Collaboration:** During the "I want to go there" activity, encourage students to work in pairs to foster collaborative learning and creativity.
- **Feedback:** Provide immediate and constructive feedback during activities to reinforce learning and correct misunderstandings.
